



The Kraken was created when a squid was sucked into a sea storm and was stretched and stretched; the squid then transformed into a deformed beast.


The Kraken's weakness is its eye - it will never ever be able to see again. Piercing its pupil will put an end to this monstrosity.

That night was glorious night for the villagers.






enhanced, providing it with the ability to see its prey from miles away. It could not be overpowered. Its weakness was its tentacles -

however this monstrosity would not just allow anyone to slay it.



After Stubbins death, the monster fled to Mariana Trench, feasting on large sharks and whales.




The legend started in the late 14th century as people began to expand their horizons and set out on epic adventures across the sea. This is when the Kraken was first classified as a cephalopod.

Habitat




Weakness







This beast eats anything from the tiniest morsel to an entire planet! Though it especially loves to feed on humans. The only thing it hates is ice.




